2024 Fall Tier 2 Session (9 weeks):

Wednesdays, September 25, October 2, 9, 16, 23, 30, November 6, 13, 20 with live sessions from 6 pm - 8 pm

2025 Winter Tier 2 Session (9 weeks):

Wednesdays, January 15, 22, 29, February 5, 12, 19, 26, March 5, 12 with live sessions from 5 pm - 7 pm

2025 Winter Tier 3 Session (10 weeks):

Thursdays, January 9, 16, 23, 30, February 6, 13, 20, 27, March 6, 13 with live sessions from 6 pm - 8 pm

Cost: \$750/participant for Tier 2 and \$850/participant for Tier 3, with 15% discount for districts who send three or more staff members. Course fees include a complimentary NAETISL membership to enrollees for continuing education opportunities and mentors who can provide language-specific support.
